## RWI (English)

- Set 1, 2 and 3 sounds.
- Blending and segmenting words orally.
- Reading red words (tricky words) by sight.
- Writing using our phonic sounds.
- Using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.
- Writing sentences independently.
- We will also re-tell the Three Little Pigs and write and innovated story of Zog.

## Mathematics NCTEM

- 2D and shape .
- Addition and Subtraction.
- Numbers 0 – 10.
- Mastery number
- 2 times tables.

## Religion

- Learn the story of creation.
- Take part in celebrations that give thanks and praise.
- Understand that there are different celebrations throughout the year.
- Know that Jesus taught people how to live through parables.

## Science

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including **wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock**.
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials (e.g. **hard/soft, smooth/rough, bendy/stiff, waterproof/absorbent**).
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their physical properties.



## Art and DT

- The children will use their skills to use different shapes to create a castle drawing. They will build up to this by understanding how we can use the shapes to build different objects.
- Within DT we will be creating an object we can move using sliders and levers.
- Afternoon tea sandwich making morning.

## History and Geography

- Learn about Kings, Queens and Castles
- Understand and re tell the story of William the Conqueror
- An exciting trip to Warwick Castle to see the castle and understand the things the children have been learning about.
