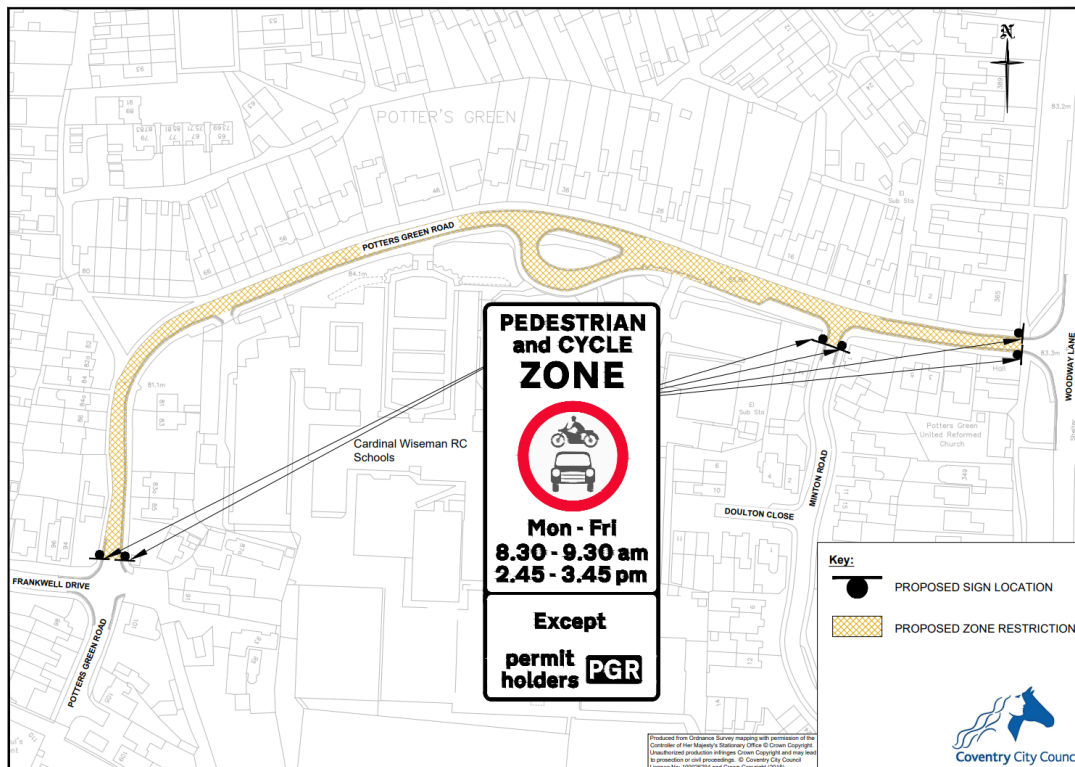




School Street Scheme

Coventry City Council have implemented a School Street Scheme in four schools across the city including Cardinal Wiseman. The scheme restricts roads to traffic moving through an area for a short time at the start and end of the day.

Please see the below image for the roads covered by the scheme:



The scheme is in operation from **8:30am – 9:30am** and **2:45pm – 3:45pm** every weekday. Anyone driving through the two points on Potters Green Road, Wedgwood Close, Minton Road and Dalton Close may receive a fixed penalty fine from the Council which is currently set at £70.00.

For parents/carers at either end of the day who use a car, please arrange a meeting point within a short walking distance of the school (see overleaf) so that you can avoid congesting this road within the time stated. We have demarcated a ten-minute walking zone of the school to help your timing.

Safe travelling to school



ANPR cameras

Capture licence plates of vehicles travelling through section of Potters Green Road, between the times of enforcement at the start and end of the day detailed on the sign.

This red highlighted section of Potters Green Road shows the location of the **traffic movement enforcement**; there are signs at either end with an ANPR camera.

Driving through the signs in the time zones identified at either end of this section of road, will trigger a fixed penalty fine because of a 'moving traffic offence'.
