GCSE Results Day & Sixth Form Application / Enrolment – Thursday 20 August 2026

We are looking forward to welcoming our students back to receive their GCSE results and celebrate accordingly. **For those students hoping to continue their studies at Cardinal Wiseman, you will also complete the application process for the Sixth Form at this time.**

Please find below details of the arrangements for collecting results together with answers to frequently asked questions:

Where do I pick up my results?

Access to the school will be via Reception. On arrival, you will be signposted to the Sixth Form Centre where results will be issued.

What time can I pick up my results?

The school will be open from 09:00am – 10:30am.

What if I am away on holiday and am unable to collect my results? Using your school email address, please inform the Exams Team (exams.cw@romeromac.com). They will arrange for your results to be sent to you.

What information will get?

- For each Examination Board, you will receive a statement detailing the results for each of your subjects. For each subject, your statement of results will show your marks for the examination paper and the overall grade that you have achieved.
- If you have achieved the entry requirements to study Level 3 qualifications at Cardinal Wiseman Sixth Form, your envelope will have an application form and information on your Pathway Options.

How do I apply to study at Cardinal Wiseman Sixth Form?

- For those students who have achieved the entry requirements to study Level 3 qualifications at Cardinal Wiseman, there will be members of staff available to discuss subject choices. If you already have specific career aspirations, our staff will be able to recommend the most relevant subjects to study. In addition to subject specific entry requirements, students must also achieve a minimum of **grade 4 in both Maths and English**. Full details are available on the school website.



- Having identified the subjects that you wish to study, you will be able to complete your application for Cardinal Wiseman Sixth Form.
- If you are unable to come into school because you are on holiday, please email Mrs Novsarka at a.novsarka@romeromac.com. In your email, include the three courses you would like to study, ensuring you meet the entry requirements for each. Please also attach a copy of your results. You will receive an acknowledgement email.

On the afternoon of Results Day, an admissions panel will review all applications. Note that there is a maximum number of 115 places for study in year 12. Should the number of applications exceed 115, places will be allocated according to the criteria outlined in the School Admissions Policy.

What if I do not get the grades I need?

Should you need additional support at this time, we will work with families to ensure that every student receives guidance to progress to the next stage of their education, employment, or training. On the day, there will be members of staff, including our Careers Team to give any necessary support or guidance that is needed.

If any changes to the above arrangements are necessary, the school will issue updated plans via email and social media.
