We expect all visitors, including parents, carers and relatives of our pupils to:

	Respect the caring ethos of our school	
	Understand that the school staff and family need to work together for the benefit of our pupils	
	Treat members of the school community with respect, that means the words and actions in front of others (ie no swearing, aggressive body language)	
	Approach staff to resolve issues in a calm and constructive way	
	Support your own child's behaviour, especially in public, where it could otherwise lead to conflict, aggressive behaviour or unsafe behaviour	
	Seek to clarify a child's version of events with the school's view, in order to bring about a peaceful solution to any issues	

Please note that inappropriate behaviour could lead to the withdrawal of permission, for a parent/carers/relative to enter the school for a period of time. Alternative arrangements will need to be put in place for child to attend school or any meetings held. In a severe incident, police will be contacted and Community Protection Warning may be issued.
