



Use the below examples to teach the capital letters the children in your class need to practise.


Start at the top of the sponge and make the down stroke first.


- 1. **Show** the children how to write the letter

- 3. Children **check** their letter with their partner.



































- 1. Curve round to the bottom of the jam

- 3. Line from the middle of the jam to the bottom of the jam.





- 1. Straight down

- 2. Curve round the bottom sponge-follow the shape of an egg.
